QUICK OVERVIEW & WHO IS ALLOWED TO START

Event:	International Challenge Grand Prix 2006
Place:	Racetrack ERC Wiener Neudorf Tennisstrasse 1, 2351 Wiener Neudorf, Austria
Organiser:	ERC Wiener Neudorf
Date:	15 th to 17 th September 2006
Track:	Outdoor, Asphalt
Who is allowed to start:	First of all: everybody who has a car that fits in one of the classes. But there is one extra rule: If you won a German, Austrian, European or World Championship in the GTI/Mini/Sport class you must not start in the GTI class. If you won a German, Austrian, European or World Championship in the Stock class, you may only start in the 17T or Super Sport class. This limitation is only counting for three years from the date of your victory.
Classes:	GTI, Stock, 17T, Super Sport and Nitro Sport (following Austrian rules).

BOOKING

For booking please fill out the entry form on the last page. We need your name (last name, first name), 3 frequencies and the class you want to race in. If you are under 18 years old, please mark it on the entry form.

As we use an AMBrc 2002 timekeeping system, it is possible to use personal transponder. So please give your number for the Transponder on the entry form.

If you use a DSM system, just place a short notice "DSM" instead of the frequencies. But if you use a Synthesizer system, please give us 3 frequencies you want to use. It is not enough to write "Synth"!

The last day for booking will be the 18th August 2006. Please sign in early because there is a limit of 150 drivers. If your entry cannot be accepted you will be informed by the organisers (if possible).

Three weeks before the race we will publish a drivers list on our homepage: www.Erc-WrNeudorf.com. Each country has to elect one teamleader who must be known by name to the organisers (latest at training start).

Entry fee: € 20.- / class (It is **not** possible to start in two or more classes!!!)
The entry fee has to be paid on Friday, 15th September by the teamleader.

TRANSPONDER

The organiser will give you a transponder. Each driver is responsible for the given transponder and has to pay for damage or loss.

The usage of AMBrc Personal Transponder is possible. Please do not forget to give your number on the entry form.

TRACK

The track area is about 60m long and about 35m wide. The track itself is 250 m long and has an average width of 3m. We offer a covered paddock with about 90 places. If the paddock should be too small an extra tent will be built-on.

There will be an extra reserved area for Nitro racers in the paddock. As we need some space for the Technical Commissars and the Nitro racers, it is not possible to reserve any places in the paddock.

The rostrum is big enough for 15 drivers and also has a roof. In front of the track there is a large parking place (also for campers). It is **not possible** to sleep directly at the track! But it is possible to place campers and caravans on the parking place very near to the track and to sleep there. No tents possible! This parking place is reserved for participants during the whole weekend, so everybody gets a display allowing him to park. It is forbidden to barbecue on this parking place by the local police! Please follow the instructions of the persons controlling the parking place.

Tables, seats und electric power will be at the track. Please bring your own extension cables and splitters.

Next to the track is a large recreation centre (about 50m) with WC and showers.

TIMETABLE

HOW TO GET THERE

Wiener Neudorf is about 20 km south of Vienna and can be reached easily with the motorway A2.

From the South or through Vienna via motorway A2:

- Exit Mödling
- Right - direction SCS (Shopping City Süd)
- First possibility after exit again right (behind „blaue Lagune“ - Musterhäuser)
- Passing „UCI“ and crossing the exit straight ahead to "PALMERS" (Attention – very sharp left turn!).
- At the next crossing right and again right next possibility, driving into "Tennisstrasse". The track is at the end of the road.

From the West via highway A1:

- On A1 to Vienna until junction, then onto A21 (Hochstrass)
- On A21 until junction to A2 direction Graz
- Exit Mödling
- Right - direction SCS (Shopping City Süd)
- First possibility after exit again right (behind „blaue Lagune“ - Musterhäuser)
- Passing „UCI“ and crossing the exit straight ahead to "PALMERS" (Attention – very sharp left turn!).
- At the next crossing right and again right next possibility, driving into "Tennisstrasse". The track is at the end of the road.
